# About the Show

This show is a chance to display your home-grown vegetables and flowers, home-made preserves, home produce and other pieces of creativity for the chance to win a Show Award, or just for the fun of it. The very first show was held in the Lister Hall in 1928, just after completion of its construction.

In this Schedule, all the classes for the competition are listed. To enter the Show, please complete and return the entry form as instructed. Don't forget to check the rules.

## Show Awards

- An old Lister trophy will be awarded to the individual competitor that receives the highest number of points in each section. The winner of the vegetable section will be awarded the Dave Butterfield Cup.
- A separate trophy will be awarded to the competitor that receives the highest number of points across the whole Show.
- Winners may have their photo taken with the trophy as a memento, but due to their historical value, they will not be available to take away from the Chantry Centre.

## COMPETITION CLASSES

Section 1

### Flowers

---

*Open to all ages*

- 101** Single rose – home grown cut flower in a vase
- 102** Any other single home grown cut flower in a vase
- 103** A mixture of cut culinary herbs displayed in a jam jar
- 104** Informal flower arrangement in a recycled container
- 105** Flowers that attract butterflies or bees – cut flowers in a jam jar
- 106** Miniature flower arrangement – not to exceed 7.5cms
- 107** Selection of seed heads displayed in a vase

## Section 2

# Vegetables and fruits

---

### *Open to all ages*

- 201** 3 Carrots
- 202** 3 Round beetroot
- 203** 2 Courgettes
- 204** 3 Onions
- 205** 5 Potatoes of the same variety
- 206** Longest runner bean
- 207** 6 French beans
- 208** 6 Runner beans
- 209** 6 Cherry tomatoes
- 210** 6 Tomatoes of the same type – salad, beefsteak or plum
- 211** 2 Cucumbers
- 212** Collection of pumpkins, gourds or squashes
- 213** Collection of vegetables arranged on a plate, 6 kinds, 2 of each kind.  
*May include edible flowers and herbs*
- 214** Comically shaped fruit or veg
- 215** 4 Cooking apples
- 216** 4 Eating apples
- 217** 6 of any other fruit not mentioned above
- 218** Collection of edible fruit arranged on a plate, minimum 4 kinds

#### *Open to all ages*

- 301** A cake made with dried fruit
- 302** A treacle tart
- 303** A Victoria Sponge filled with jam only
- 304** A lemon drizzle cake
- 305** 6 pieces of Brownie or Blondie
- 306** 6 biscuits of the same type
- 307** 6 pieces of flapjack
- 308** 4 decorated small cakes
- 309** A round of shortbread
- 310** 4 cheese scones
- 311** 3 bread rolls – handmade, any flour

*Note: For food hygiene purposes, exhibits containing fresh cream cannot be judged.*

## Section 4

### **Preserves and home produce**

---

#### *Open to all ages*

- 401** A pot of mixed fruit jam
- 402** A pot of single fruit jam
- 403** A pot of jelly
- 404** A pot of marmalade
- 405** A pot of chutney
- 406** A jar of pickle or relish
- 407** A bottle of homemade cordial or squash
- 408** A bottle of home flavoured spirit – *age 18 and over*

# Crafts

---

### *Open to all ages*

- 601 A soft toy – can be made using any techniques
- 602 A knitted or crocheted item of clothing (includes hats & bags)
- 603 A sewn item of clothing (includes hats & bags)
- 604 A household item made using any technique (cushions, tea cosies etc)
- 605 An embroidered or cross stitch item
- 606 A greetings card made using any technique, max size A5
- 607 Carve an animal from a bar of soap
- 608 A door wreath not using fresh flowers or foliage
- 609 'The Transformation Challenge' – a household or clothing item made from something repurposed

## Section 7

### **17 years and under classes**

---

#### *10 years and under: help allowed with the difficult bits!*

- 701** A decorated pebble
- 702** An animal mask made from any materials
- 703** Drawing/painting of a garden or flowers – *under 6 years old*
- 704** Drawing/painting of a garden or flowers – *6-10 years old*
- 705** A garden on a plate
- 706** Decorate a small container and grow cress in it

#### *17 years and under*

- 707** Collage made using natural materials
- 708** Greetings card, maximum A5 size
- 709** A lavender bag
- 710** Make a monster or animal from fruit and/or veg
- 711** A creature made from an eggbox or eggboxes
- 712** Photograph of the natural world
- 713** Photograph of summer
- 714** Photograph – “It makes me smile”

# Show Rules

1. The Cam and Dursley Flower & Produce Show is open to everyone. Children are welcome to enter adult classes.
2. The entry fee is 50p per exhibit in the adults' classes, and 20p per exhibit in the 17 years and under classes. However, you will not be required to pay more than £5, even if you enter more than 10 classes.
3. No exhibitor can show more than one entry in each class.
4. Children's ages on the day of the show must be stated on their entry forms.
5. Entry forms are to be posted or delivered by hand to the Chantry Centre.
6. Entry fees should be paid on the day of the show when exhibits are delivered to the Chantry Centre.
7. All exhibits must be the result of unaided work by the exhibitor.
8. All exhibits to be displayed at the Chantry Centre, Long Street, Dursley by 9.30am on the day of the Show.
9. Exhibitors must provide their own vases for display of exhibits.
10. Root vegetable tops must have foliage trimmed back to approx. 8cm. Onions must have roots trimmed, tops tied down and loose skin removed. Tomatoes must be displayed with calyces. Peas and beans must be displayed with some stalk attached. Fruit should be displayed with stalk, but no leaves attached.
11. Points will be awarded in all classes. 3 for first, 2 for second, 1 for third.
12. The judge's decision will be final.
13. Exhibits should have a title where possible, for the interest of visitors.
14. Cam and Dursley Flower and Produce Show and the Chantry Centre cannot be held responsible for any show exhibit that is lost, stolen or damaged.
15. With the exhibitor's permission, photos from the photography classes may be displayed permanently in the Chantry Centre.
16. To conform with Health & Safety regulations ALL EDIBLE exhibits must be covered eg film, Perspex. Preserves must be named and dated and sealed with a suitable film top or lid.

Deliver or post your entry form to arrive at the Chantry Centre by 6.00pm on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2026.

Bring your competition entries to:

- The Chantry Centre, 34-36 Long Street, Dursley, GL11 4JB between 8.00am and 9.30am on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2026 (the morning of the Show).
- Judging will take place 10.00 - 11.30am.  
Everyone will be asked to vacate the hall while this takes place.
- The Show will open to the public at 12.00 noon with free admission for everyone.
- Trophies will be awarded at 12.30.
- Your entries can be collected from the hall from 2.00pm.
